Cookies & Similar Tracking Technology

We use cookies and similar tracking technology (collectively, “Cookies”) to collect and use personal information about you, including to serve interest-based advertising.

Buzzdotnet (Pty)Ltd.com may use cookies (small text files stored in a user’s browser) or web beacons (electronic images that allow this platform to count users who have accessed a particular page and to access certain cookies) to ensure that the platform is well managed and to facilitate improvement of the site. Buzzdotnet (Pty)Ltd.com or its service provider(s) may use cookies to collect aggregate data. Buzzdotnet (Pty)Ltd.com may use such devices from time to time to track information on its systems and identify categories of users by items such as IP addresses, domains, browser types and pages visited. 11. We need to perform a contract with you, which you have given us permission to do so.
12. The processing is in our legitimate interests, and it is not overridden by your rights.
13. For payment processing purposes.
14. To comply with the law.

Retention of Information:

You agree to allow us to keep your personal information after we have finished processing it for its original purpose. You can ask us to delete any information we have of you by making a request in writing.

Buzzdotnet (Pty)Ltd will retain your personal information only for as long as is necessary for the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy. We will retain and use your personal information to the extent necessary to comply with our legal obligations (for example, if we are required to retain your information to comply with applicable laws), resolve disputes, and enforce our legal agreements and policies. Buzzdotnet (Pty)Ltd will also retain usage information for internal analysis purposes.

Disclosure to third parties

Although Buzzdotnet (Pty)Ltd.com may provide users' information to service providers that handle information on its behalf, it will usually not share the information with third parties or other public entities for secondary or unrelated purposes unless otherwise disclosed at the point of collection.
